FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The Board will maintain a school lunch program in each school. The lunch program will be designed to provide each child with nutritious meals.

The supervisors of food services (financial and production) will be responsible to the superintendent who will have overall charge of the organization and management of food services.

The Board will approve the prices charged children and adults for meals.

When a student's meal account reaches a zero balance, the student will be allowed to charge no more than three meals. If the student has charged three (3) meals and has not deposited any money into his/her account, then the student may be denied being served that meal at the discretion of the food service director and/or the building administrator. Each building will establish its own procedure for notifying parents when meal account balances are nearing zero.
