EMERGENCY CLOSING

The authority to cancel or dismiss schools early in weather or other emergencies which threaten the safety of students lies with the superintendent. In the event of the superintendent's absence, authority is delegated through the normal line and staff organization.

When emergencies arise during the school day, suitable arrangements will be made for pupils who live in rural areas and cannot reach home under the existing conditions.

The superintendent will communicate with people in Lonetree, Robertson, Carter, Fort Bridger, the transportation director and the county shop and ask their advice about adverse weather conditions in those areas.

Selected radio stations will be used for informing students, parents and staff about school closings.

The district will also use the Swift K12 Alert System as a means of communicating emergency school closures.
