

STUDENT TEACHING AND INTERNSHIPS

The Board recognizes the responsibility of the school system for cooperating with teacher training institutions in the placement of student teachers.

In the placement of student teachers, the superintendent or his designee will:

1. Provide for their placement with outstanding teachers of the district who will serve as their supervisors.
2. Protect pupils from overexposure to student teaching, and teachers from excessive supervisory responsibilities toward student teachers.

The first responsibility of the district is to the students within its schools. If, at any time, a student teacher becomes unacceptable, the district reserves the right to refuse the student further teaching experiences.

Agreement on Tuition Waivers

The Board has agreed to the following policy established by the University of Wyoming in regard to tuition waivers for school systems which place its students for Student Teaching.

1. School districts shall be permitted to earn and accumulate registration fee scholarships based on three hours per University of Wyoming student teachers working within the district.
 - a. Such hours will become void after three years of nonuse.
 - b. The University will keep records of the total number of hours accruing to any school district at a given time.
 1. Such computation will be made on the basis of the hours accumulated, with the earliest date being used first, and voided (a. above) upon three years of nonuse.
 2. Each public school district will be notified as of May 1 annually as to the number of hours available to the district.
 3. Use of registration fee scholarships authorized under this policy will be limited to certified public school teachers and administrators selected by the school district.
2. Pro-rating of accumulated hours will be the responsibility of the public school district within the limitations of b.2. above.

3. Registration fee scholarships will be authorized upon presentation of approved form at registration.
4. The teachers who supervise student teachers will be given the first opportunity to use registration fee scholarships which they earn. If not used after one year, the scholarships will be made available on a first come-first served basis, with priority given to the supervising teachers for the next two years.
