SCHOOL BUILDING ADMINISTRATOR

Acting with the approval of the superintendent, each principal shall be the chief administrator of his or her school.

The school principal shall be responsible for supervision and direction of staff; assignment and control of students; the overall purchasing; and overall success of the instructional programs; supervision of budgeting and equipment. In all of these areas, the principal is responsible for Board policies and district requirements, the principal may establish and enforce staff and student rules needed for the coded according to the organization of the policy manual and approved by the superintendent.

The school principal shall actively seek the advice of the staff and any school advisory committee, but the principal alone has responsibility and authority to make administrative decisions.

Itinerant staff members (classified or professional), while responsible to central office administrators, shall work closely under the principals and shall be under the principal's direction while working in a school.
