

POLICY IMPLEMENTATION/DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS

Regulations shall be developed to implement Board policy.

The Board delegates to the superintendent authority to develop, approve and issue regulations and operating procedures necessary for the successful functioning of the schools.

At the school level, principals, together with their staffs, shall have the responsibility and authority to develop such rules and procedures as may be needed for effective school and classroom management and the implementation of Board policy and district regulations and procedures.

In order that pertinent Board policies, district regulations and departmental and/or school rules and procedure may be known by all staff members and students affected by them, district administrators and principals are granted authority to issue staff and student handbooks as found necessary and desirable.

It is essential that the contents of all handbooks conform with district-wide policies and regulations. Therefore, the Board and/or superintendent shall review all handbooks prior to publication.
