

## SAFETY PROGRAM

The Board shall adhere to Wyoming State Statutes regarding safety in our school system.

Maintenance of a healthful and safe school environment is a responsibility shared by the Board, staff and students.

Principals shall supervise safe and healthful practices in their schools and teachers in their classrooms. Observance of safety rules will be required on the part of staff and students.

When children are ill or injured, first aid will be administered by the school nurse, principal or staff member trained in first aid, as soon as possible. Parents or guardians will be notified if the injury or illness is serious. (Under no circumstances will a child be sent home unattended.)

It is the responsibility of each principal to establish procedures within the framework of district policy for the handling of emergency care.

First aid will be given to all persons injured on school property. Accident reports will be filed on all accidents occurring on school property, suffered by students while under school jurisdiction or by employees when on duty.
