

COMPETITIVE FOOD SALES

Uinta County School District No. Four is concerned about providing students with the best possible nutrition at the schools. Proper nutrition is important for both physical and educational development. Nourishing meals assist children in making the most of their educational opportunities.

Accordingly, it is the policy of the district that the sale of minimal nutritional value food shall be prohibited throughout the beginning 30 minutes before the start of the school day until 30 minutes after the end of the school day.

Foods and beverages sold outside of reimbursable school meals, such as through vending machines, cafeteria a la carte, fundraisers, school stores, etc. shall meet state and federal guidelines.
